Septic System Inspections ***Chapter 69.3(1)***

- **Pre-Site Inspection:** Prior to breaking ground.
- **Mid Inspections:** Per Discretion of the Environmental Health Officer Inspector and noted at time of pre-site.
- **Inspections:**

Primary System

Septic Tanks Schedule 40 PVC shall extend at least 2' beyond undisturbed ground
Minimum of 3' of undisturbed ground between tank and secondary Prior to cover; or
per discretion of Inspector noted at time of pre-site Minimum liquid Depth 40" and
Maximum liquid Depth 6 1/2' from lid Clean out required every 100' prior to tank
Evidence of pipe cleaner (prefer colored) on all PVC joints
Risers at grade

Secondary System

Sand Filters:

EZ Flow: Probe of 34" of Sand prior to cover
(top of sand to bottom of excavation), may be after installation of EZ flow.
Bottom common vent with siphon/dose; top and bottom vents for gravity
(2) 10" bottom pipes prior to cover; corrugated poly tubing with socks
Evidence of pipe cleaner (prefer colored)
3' or greater from Septic Tank
4" schedule 40 PVC pipe
Varmint Guard
Filter Fabric

Bio Filters/Recirculating Textile Filters:

Prior to cover; or per discretion of Inspector noted at time of pre-site.
Inspect inside of peat moss and textile filters
Connections to septic tank
Vent lid free from cover

Final Approval of Onsite Wastewater Disposal System:

Receipt of signed maintenance agreement if applicable
Documented tank location via GPS coordinates.
Document overall system with digital camera
Completion of Chapter 69.3(1) B Checklist
EHO Signature on Original permit
Finalize drawing of the system
